3. 2024 Park Partnership Program Applications
Contracts Administrator, Jackson

Two (2) eligible applications were received for the 2024 Park Partnership Program. The program offers matching fund grants to eligible applicants making improvements to city-owned parks, trails, open space, and recreation facilities.

Purple Sage Riders Chapter of the Back Country Horsemen of Washington
Dawn Kammenzind presented their proposed projects at W.E. Johnson
Park.

Requested amount: \$4,000

Tri-City Radio Modelers

Vice President Castaneda presented the proposed project located at 5000
Beardsley Rd.

Requested amount: \$6,669

Commissioner Buelt moved that the Parks and Recreation Commission recommend that the Richland City Council approve the funding for the Park Partnership Program applications from Purple Sage Riders Chapter of the Back Country Horsemen of Washington in the amount of \$4,000 and from Tri-City Radio Control Modelers in the amount of \$6,669. Vice Chair Gutierrez seconded the motion. Motion approved 8-0

4. **Columbia Park West**
Deputy City Manager, Schiessl

Schiessl updated the commission for the recreational users located at Columbia Park West. Schiessl explained that there is a meal train service for those in need operating at the park shelter, causing conflict with other park users. Discussion

was had with the Army Corp of Engineers and the City, and an alternate location at Columbia Park West was suggested to operate this service. Schiessl also explained that the City encouraged and supported this operation to become a non-profit organization so that the meal service operation would operate out of a brick and mortar and off public property and have access to a commercial kitchen.

No recommendation was needed for the business item; it was a discussion only.

Richland Parks and Recreation Commission Workshop

Richland Community Center – Meeting Room

Thursday, April 25, 2024 ~ 6:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER:

Chair Mason called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

ATTENDANCE:

Chair Mason and Commissioners Buelt, Hodges, Thallapally, and Gubba were present.

Commissioners Vice Chair Gutierrez, Commissioners Lunstad, and Cunningham were absent.

Also in attendance were Deputy City Manager Schiessl, Recreation Manager Piper, and Interim Public Works Director D'Alessandro.

PRESENTATIONS:

1. 2024-2029 Transportation Improvement Program Presentation Interim Public Works Director D'Alessandro

D'Alessandro presented the draft of the six-year Transportation Improvement Plan to the commission.

RCW 35.77.010 requires local jurisdictions to prepare and adopt a perpetual six-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The City's TIP is combined with other state and local agency TIPs into a state-wide STIP. The TIP is used primarily to manage the expenditure of state and federal funds. Richland's long-standing practice of preparing its TIP involves multiple public involvement opportunities, including the involvement of the Parks & Recreation Commission and Planning Commission. Public meetings to consider the TIP will be held by the Parks & Recreation Commission and the Planning Commission. The Parks & Recreation Commission is requested to vote at the following Parks and Recreation Commission meeting scheduled in May.

D'Alessandro engaged in a question-and-answer conversation regarding the draft 2025-2030 Transportation Improvement Plan with the commission.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

2. Harmful Algal Blooms Deputy City Manager Schiessl

Deputy City Manager Schiessl summarized the previous discussion from the Health District end-of-season Harmful Cyanobacterial Blooms presentation, reports, and information on harmful algal blooms with the commission. Discussion focused on the public health considerations at the Howard Amon Park swim dock. Schiessl engaged in a question-and-answer conversation with the commission during the presentation.

Item will be moved for a recommendation at the next meeting in May.

3. 2024 Parks and Recreation Commission Goals Chair Mason

Chair Mason led the discussion of the 2024 Parks and Recreation Commission's Goals to familiarize the new commission members.

The commission engaged in question-and-answer regarding the 2024 goals. Discussion will continue at the next workshop.

4. 2024 Park Tour Agenda Planning

The commission discussed locations for the tour, and a poll will be sent out with dates for the 2024 Parks and Recreation Commission Park Tour.

Summary:
RCW 35.77.010 requires local jurisdictions to prepare and adopt a perpetual six-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The City's TIP is combined with other state and local agency TIPs into a state-wide STIP. The STIP is used primarily to manage expenditure of state and federal funds. For the City, the TIP indicates the priority transportation improvements for which the City intends to apply for state and federal grant funding. Richland's long-standing practice of preparing its TIP involves multiple public involvement opportunities that include involvement of the Parks & Recreation Commission and Planning Commission. The draft TIP is posted on the City's website with an opportunity to provide comments. Public meetings to consider the TIP will be held by the Parks & Recreation Commission and the Planning Commission. The Parks & Recreation Commission is requested to vote to recommend approval of the proposed TIP. RCW 35.77.010 requires a public hearing before adoption of the City's TIP. A public hearing will be advertised and held at the Council meeting to accept additional public comment on the topic. Barring any compelling public testimony to the contrary, staff will recommend a resolution for adoption of the TIP if recommended by the Parks and Recreation Commission and the Planning Commission.

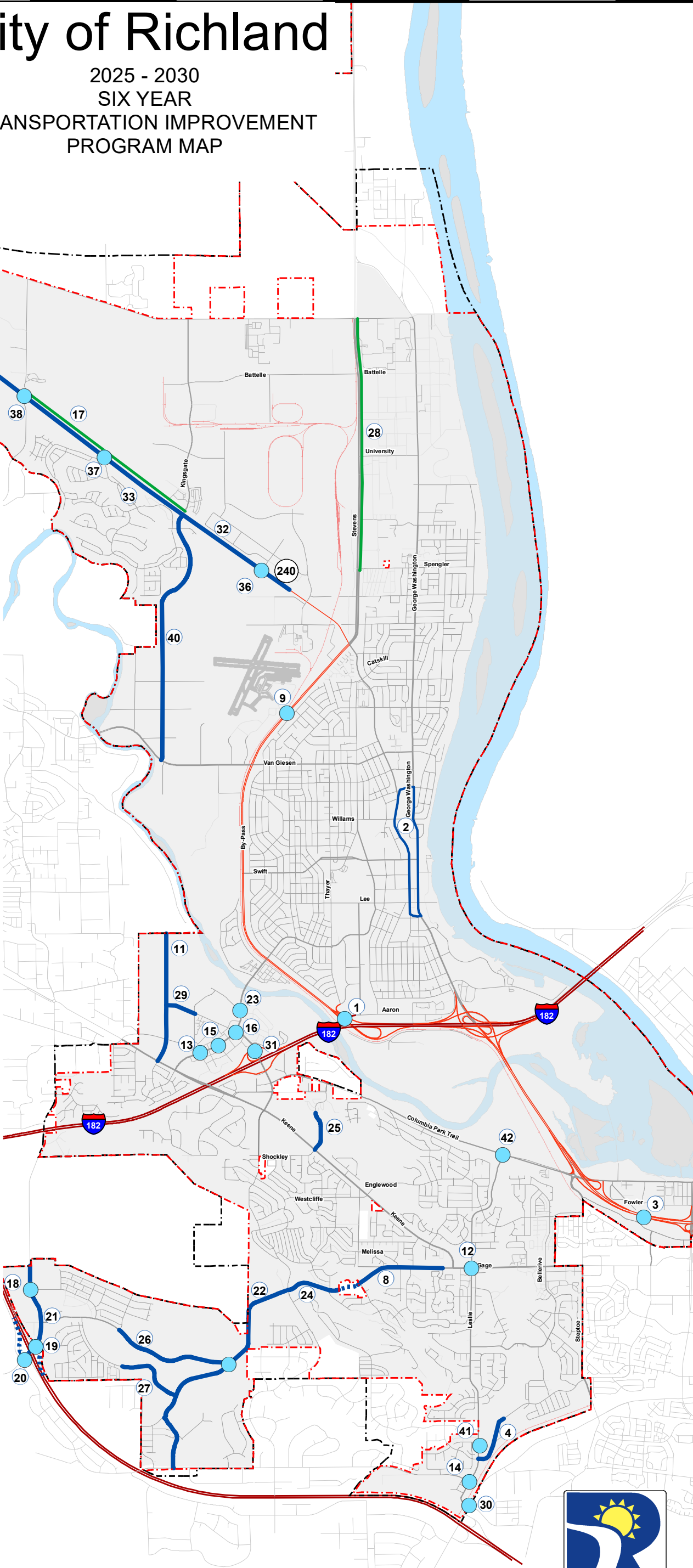

Recommended Motion:

The Parks and Recreation Commission recommends that the City Council pursue the Benton Franklin Health District recommendation No. 1 to close the Howard Amon swim dock.

Summary:

In 2023, the Benton Franklin Health District (BFHD) conducted a toxin monitoring program at multiple sites along the Columbia River due to the presence of algal blooms. One site of recreational importance that was monitored was the Howard Amon swim dock. The 2023 monitoring identified findings that could impact public health during recreational use of the swim dock. BFHD provided three recommendations regarding the dock. Each has a different recreational impact on the community.

Recommendation 1- Close the swimming dock

Recommendation 2- Have staff use manual means to remove algae daily at the swimming dock.

Recommendation 3- Install a mechanical system that filters or increases turbidity in the swimming area to reduce algae.
