Subject

Automated Traffic Enforcement (30 minutes)

Summary

Staff has been evaluating the use of Automated Traffic Enforcement to supplement law enforcement efforts. Automated Traffic Enforcement has been found to be an effective method of altering driver behavior and is recommended by both the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the Washington Traffic Safety Commission.

In 2024, the Washington State Legislature made substantial changes to automated speed enforcement laws providing additional opportunities for municipal use of speed safety cameras.

Staff will provide information for discussion and will seek direction on whether Council has an interest in the future authorization of automated traffic enforcement.
