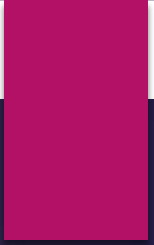

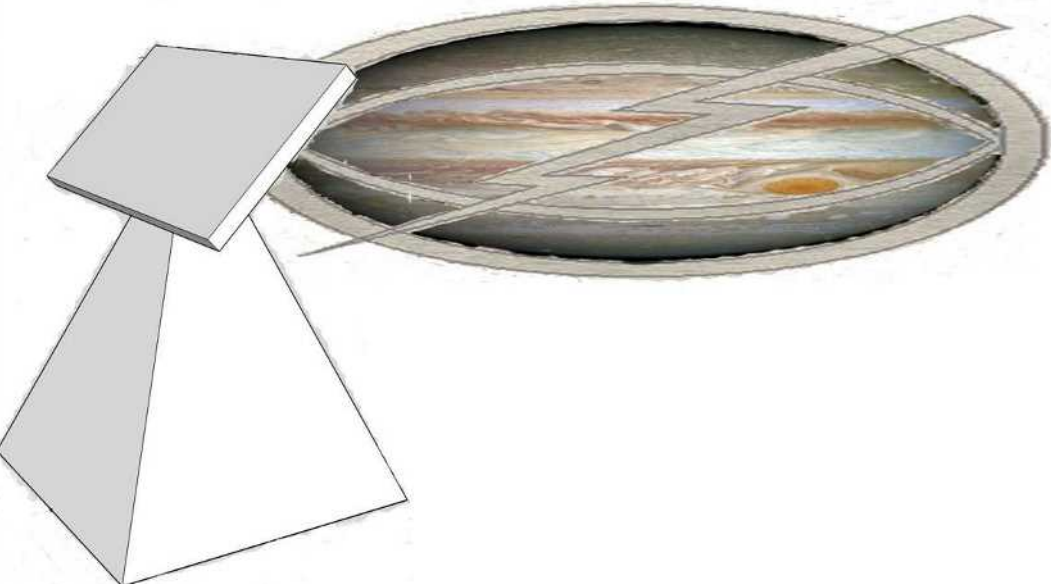


The Art

4ft diameter metal inlay



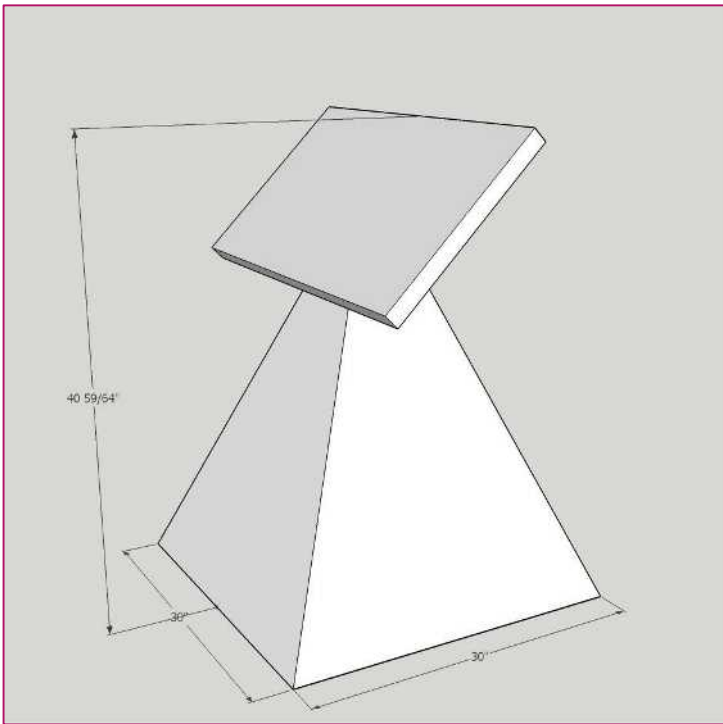

The Pedestal



- ▶ Will be custom fabricated onsite from concrete
- ▶ Meier Architecture created the structural engineering blueprints
- ▶ Provides description of the art and theater

Summary

- ▶ All aspects of the design were created for low maintenance
- ▶ Concrete and metal inlays will withstand Richland summers and winters
- ▶ An electric outlet will be installed for outdoor staging events
- ▶ A \$1000 maintenance fund is available
- ▶ This project has the support of the Richland BID, The Richland Players Theater, and SILAS Education
- ▶ Will be funded by the Richland Parkway Improvement Association (Richland Farmers' Market)
