Summary:

Washington State Law requires the City to prepare a six-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) each year. The City's TIP is integrated into regional and state Transportation Improvement Program's in an effort to assemble an integrated multi-jurisdictional system plan. The TIP's primary functions are to: 1) publicly establish the City's transportation system improvement goals for the coming six-year period; and 2) support management of state and federal funds applied to transportation system improvements. The TIP preparation schedule is dictated by a state-wide schedule of program preparation and adoption and requires that the City adopt its contribution to the TIP, by Council resolution, by July 1st of each year.

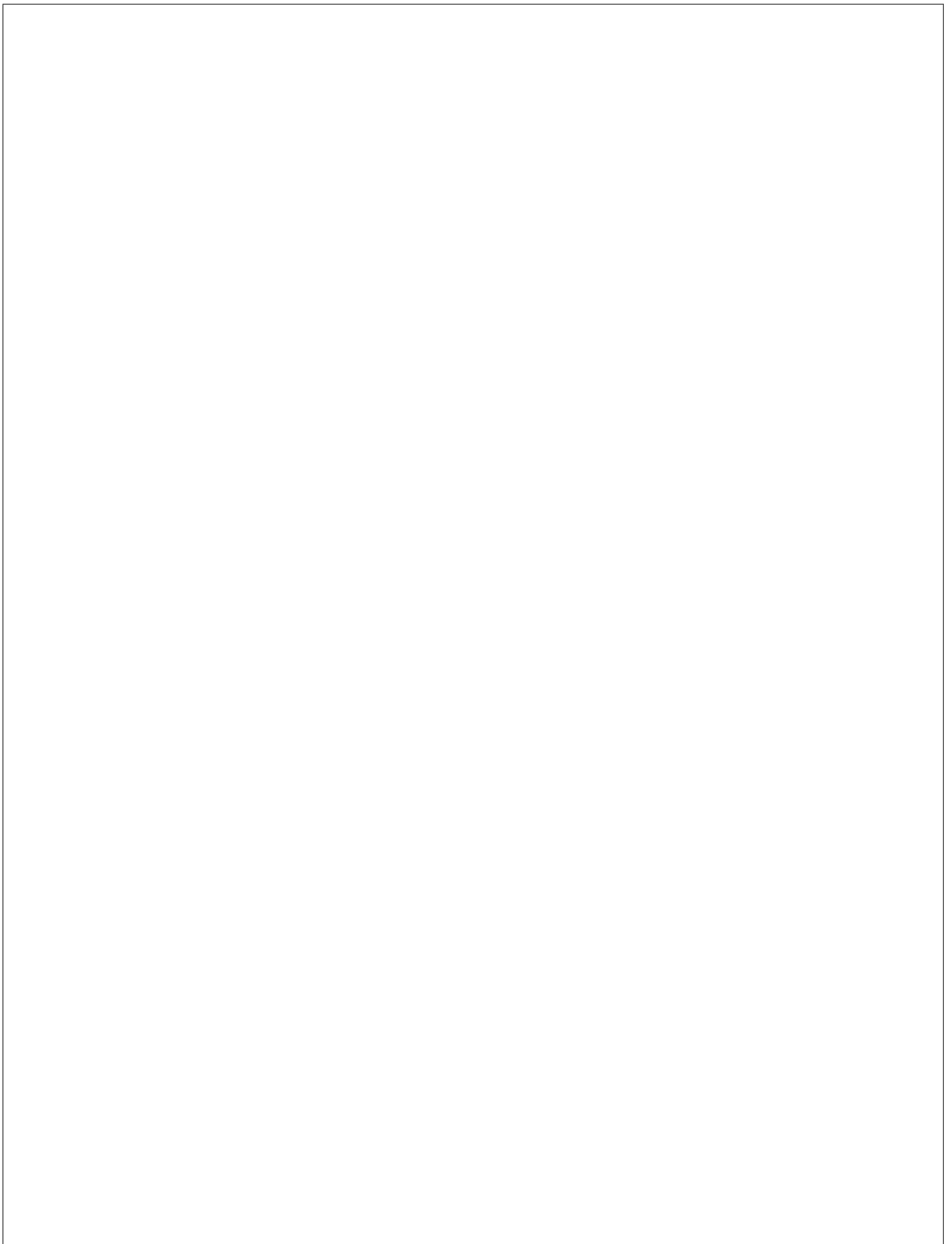
The City conducts a very thorough public involvement program each year to support the Council's TIP adoption process. By State regulation, the City is required to conduct one public hearing in its process. The City typically conducts three public meetings during its process, one each at the Planning Commission, Parks and Recreation Commission, and one that is run as a formal public hearing at City Council. Tonight's workshop will include a staff briefing to familiarize the Commission with this year's draft TIP in preparation for its public meeting on the topic on June 10.

The Parks and Recreation's consideration of the TIP is not mandated by the State or the municipal code. The Commission's duties, as defined in Richland Municipal Code (RMC) Section 2.18.040, guide the Commission's role with regard to the TIP. RMC 2.18.040 E speaks to the Commission advising Council by completing a "Review, comment and make recommendations on the annual city long range transportation plan with respect to bicycle lanes, trails and multi-use trails." A graphic presentation of the general location and description of projects to be included in the TIP is attached. 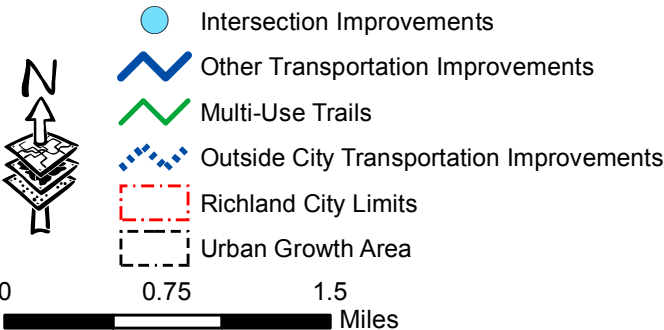
