Hi Julie,

It was so great meeting you yesterday and getting a tour of all the really amazing stuff going on at the community center! The opportunities you guys have going on there is amazing.

I sent my email off to Ruvim last night, but I haven't heard back. I know getting this to you is time sensitive so I figured I'd just email it to you directly. I apologize if he already sent it along and just didn't let me know.

Just a quick follow up from our conversations:

1. It would be awesome if the storm water area had some form of art or musical concept incorporated into it. We don't get rain a lot, so it would probably need to be something for dry use too...maybe it could be a big art piece that looks like a river (using large rocks or native plants) with large salmon running in it (if there ever was water in there it would look pretty neat!). For safety reasons, it would be nice if the storm water run off areas weren't landscaped with palm sized rocks. It makes an easy tool for kids to throw at each other and at passing cars.

2. The Badger Mountain South community would love a dog park for many reasons; chief among them is safety. Our current community park is being used as a dog park and it's very concerning. With the constant eb and flow of off leash pups, I constantly feel like we're a dog attack waiting to happen. There needs to be a place close by where people can let their dogs off leash safely. When our community was built, it was built with the requirement that we'd end up with two (1.5 acre) dog parks. A lot of the people who let their dogs off leash in our park feel frustrated that they might not get a single one. If the 30 acre park had a 1.5 acre dog park it would be such a relief to everyone. The kids could get their fields back, you could probably prevent dogs from peeing and pooping all over the green soccer fields you're planning on putting in, and everyone would be safer.

I think it's also important to mention that Badger Mountain South is intended to be a mixed-use community with some medium and high density living spaces. A lot of people will not have access to yards where their dogs can run around. There are already a number of homes here without yards and those are the people who bring their off leash dogs to our park. If you'd like the West Village park to be forward thinking, planning a dog park to account for the high density residents would be a big draw.

It was brought up that putting a dog park in would increase traffic to our area. Honestly, that would be great! Being a destination of sorts was part of the vision for Badger Mountain South. I can confidently say that the majority of community members strongly believes in letting BMS develop into a unique hub that attracts people from all over. Maybe it would even help us get the business district off the ground!

For what it's worth, I have talked with the Tri-Cities Dog Society. They are willing to use their non-profit status to apply for grants to help build the dog park. They also volunteered to sponsor the park once it's in place.

3. Trees!!

a. If you ever need 2-3 trees planted for whatever reason, please reach out to the Mid-Columbia Community Forestry Council (MCCFC). They are always looking for ways to plant more trees in the community. They have members from both Kennewick and Pasco's park services on their board and would love it if a representative from Richland joined. We meet the second Monday of every month (except June, July, and Aug) from 12-1pm.

b. As part of the MCCFC, my daughter and her friend have started Kids for Urban Trees. They would like to do a major tree planting within the year and apply to the DNR for a grant. If they could organize a big community tree planting in the fall at West Village park, that would be great! We need to get the grant details worked out as soon as possible. If anyone in the parks department is interested please contact me so we can talk in more detail.

4. The kids in Badger Mountain South would be over the moon for even the smallest amount of scootering/skate things. We have a large number of kids in the 12-18 age range who probably feel a little old for a traditional park play structure. It would certainly help them feel included and give them something to do at the new park. It would be the biggest, happiest surprise for them!

(I mentioned to Ruvim that the West Vineyard HOA had already reached out to the parks director/ developer regarding a dog park and a skate park/skate friendly equipment in early 2021. We were told back then that there was zero interest in pursuing either idea. This is why I was asking for at least scooter friendly stuff. Your idea of starting small and adding just a little bit at a time would be so spectacular, the kids would be so happy and grateful for that!)

5. My daughter requests a wobbly bridge and a tunnel slide.

6. Can you please tell me who you buy your benches through?

Thank you so much for your time and caring about our community. It means a lot to be listened to.

Hey all, I wanted to reach out about the Badger South project. I know the map that has been sent out is a "Draft" and maybe not the final but I'm seeing a couple things I wanted to ask about.

It appears as though you are proposing 6 courts instead of 12. Not sure if there is any way to get to 12 at this location? With the courts we appear to be getting in Kennewick (Lawrence Scott Park) and 12 at Badger South we would have a very good chance of becoming the permanent home of the Pacific Northwest Regional qualifying tournament. This would require us having 24 courts total. This is a tournament that you must play in to qualify for the National tournament down in Indian Wells California. 700-800 players here over 4-5 days of play. This may not be possible and I'll still be happy to have the extra 6 courts!!

The other thing I'm seeing is the courts appear to be in an east west configuration? This will make play on the courts very difficult in the mornings when most players are out. Also equally difficult in the evenings when those of us who still work would be able to play. Either of those times half the people playing will be looking directly into the sun. It is very important to get a North/South orientation for the courts. I could just be reading the layout wrong but wanted to put that information out there just in case they are currently set to East/West.

Very excited to see Pickleball getting new venues for our local players. Appreciate all your work on this project and Claybell too!

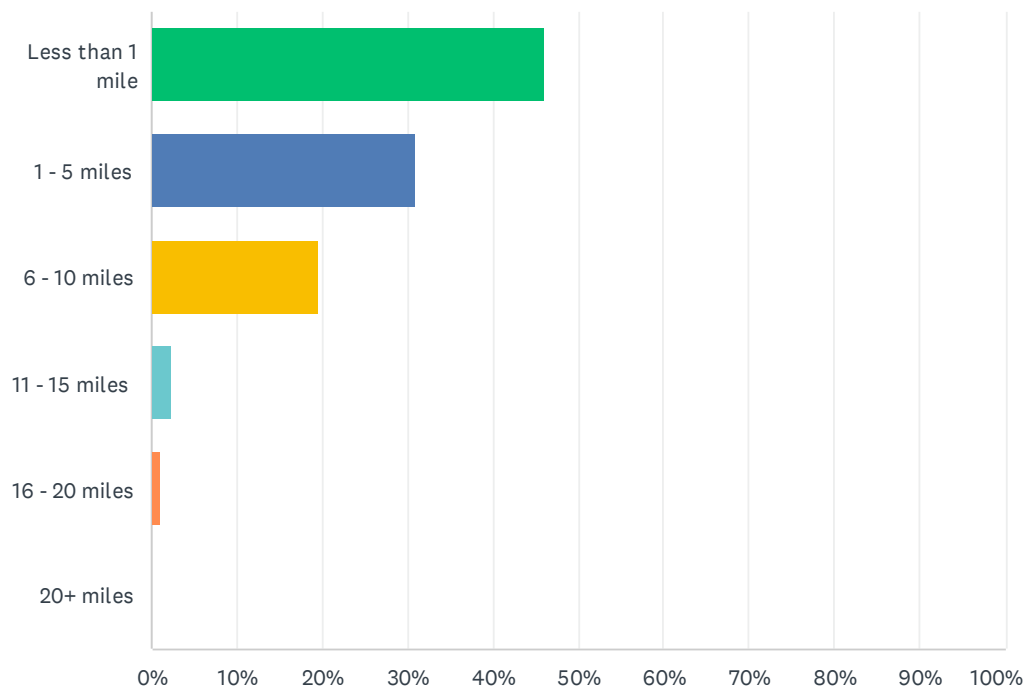

Q3 How many people from each age range live in your household?

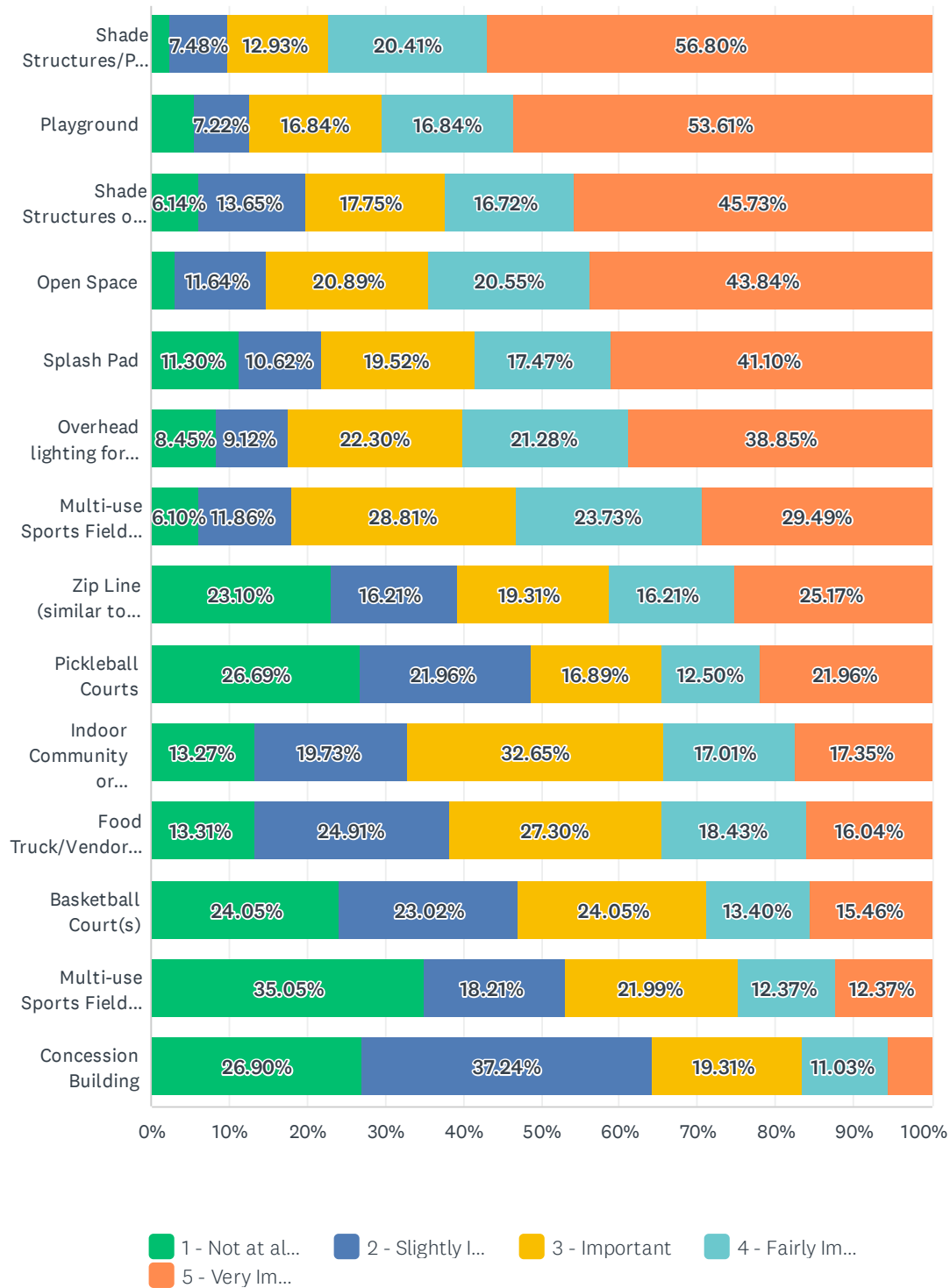
