Police Pensioner Moore inquired about HIPAA training, Cybersecurity Insurance and a possible increase to the hearing aid benefit.

Police Pension Secretary Rogers replied that she spoke with staff from the Human Resources Department and staff will contact pensioners directly to provide HIPAA training. HIPAA training will be provided on an annual basis moving forward.

Finance Director Allen replied that the City of Richland carries cybersecurity coverage and routinely undergoes cybersecurity assessments to ensure data is protected.

Police Pension Secretary Rogers replied that pensioners have a hearing aid benefit with Cigna and through the Police Pension Board Policy. Without reviewing both Police Pension Board Policy and the Cigna Benefit Summary, Police Pension Secretary Rogers estimated the hearing aid benefit to be approximately \$6,000.

Lastly, Mr. Moore expressed an interest in meeting with Mayor Alvarez to discuss issues raised in 2021. Mayor Alvarez agreed to a meeting with Mr. Moore.
